The 1000Z also revolutionized the industry with the introduction of the new Zenith Big Black Dial. The 1000Z serial numbers ran from 754001 to around 754350, indicating that around 350 sets were actually produced. According to Zenith Radio, the Early Years 1919-1935 (Schiffer Publishing Ltd.) by Harold N. Cones and John H. Bryant with Martin Blankinship and William Wade, the first 100 Stratospheres tuned to 64.3mc, but subsequent units from the second production run only tuned to 45mc. The price for the 1000Z remained at \$750.00 for its entire 4-year sales cycle. Today, there are 40 known surviving Stratospheres listed in a private registry. SN-75211.
